LITTER BUG TAG

What you will need:

- 1. Objects to scatter around the play area. You can use trash/recyclable items such as cans, plastic bottles, paper towel tubes or use balls, stuffed animals or any other object than can be picked up. This will be litter.
- 2. A basket or a box.

How to Play:

- 1. Scatter objects around the play area
- 2. Put a box/basket in the center of the play area.
- 3. Decide on who will be "it".
- 4. The "it" tries to tag the other players as they move around the play area trying to pick up the litter. They can only pick up 1 piece of litter at a time.
- 5. The players try to get the litter to the box/basket in the middle of the play area without getting tagged.
- 6. If you get tagged, you go to the box.basket and take out a piece of litter and put it back on the ground. If the basket/box is empty do 5 jumping jacks. Then return to play in the game.
- 7. Play for a certain amount of time. Count the objects in the box/basket and the ones left on the ground to decide who has won the game. Switch the "it" for the next round.

Modifications:

- 1. Use different movement patterns as you play (run, skip, gallop).
- 2. If playing indoors use walking feet only.
